
one of the central design ideas for the system is to be customisable to a wide variety of different play experiences so i think this was a super cool idea, and leemo did most of the coming up with it!


im not gonna get super deep into the mechanics of the system here, but i probably will at a later date. We still dont even have a name for it lol

They were playing in a very small and very very warm room with about 30 people? 40? A good few of the ppl there i knew or i assume knew the band personally



Also honourable mention to my jump pack captain; while not technically a real Smash Captain since she lead a unit she was running Storm Shield + Thunder Hammer, the former of which's additional wound came in clutch after i charged a squad of melee emperors children battleline (i forgor their name, incitor?
